- ❖ When – April 12-14, 2019
- ❖ Where – Camp Tekakwitha, www.CampTekakwitha.net
- ❖ Who – Middle and high school age youth and adults participating in one of the many scouting programs
 - Youth age – 11 through 17 years old. Do not bring or send younger children.
 - Individual and unit registrations accepted. Participants do not need to be registered in a Catholic sponsored unit to attend. Individuals registered without a unit will be grouped together with a staff guide.
 - Everyone (youth and adult) must be registered in a recognized Scouting association (such as Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, American Heritage Girls, etc.). Adult participants must be up to date on youth protection training.
- ❖ What – A weekend camping retreat bringing together all of the Diocese’s middle and high school age scouting youth and volunteers into one campsite neighborhood to pray, reflect, worship, and splash.
- ❖ How – Camp Tekakwitha is owned and operated by the Diocese of Birmingham and includes a dining hall, chapel, pool, lake, and many other features for a peaceful and relaxing retreat. The camping area is a short hike from the parking area so bring your backpack, tent, sleeping bag, swimsuit, a change of clothes, hygiene kit, and mess kit. Our staff of youth and adult volunteers will be serving all the meals.
- ❖ Registration and Cost – Registration is \$20 per person, please make checks out to “Office for Youth” and using the form on the next page for registering an individual participant attending as well as unit’s may use it to register multiple participants.
